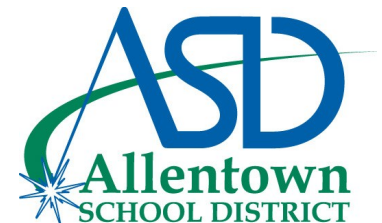

The Family Centers offer Child Development Programs to provide information and guidance to parents to help insure their children’s future success in school.

Eligibility

Allentown residents who are parents/ guardians of infants or children from birth to age five and parents-to-be during the last trimester of pregnancy.

Services

- Home visits with a Family Development Specialist certified by the nationally recognized Missouri Parents as Teachers Program and trained in Child Development.
- Child Development information.
- Toy and book lending libraries.
- Group meetings with other parents and workshops on topics of interest to parents.
- Constructive play sessions for parents and their children.
- Periodic developmental screening in social, language, intellectual and motor skill areas, and vision and hearing for early detection of sensory problems.
- Referral for needed services.
